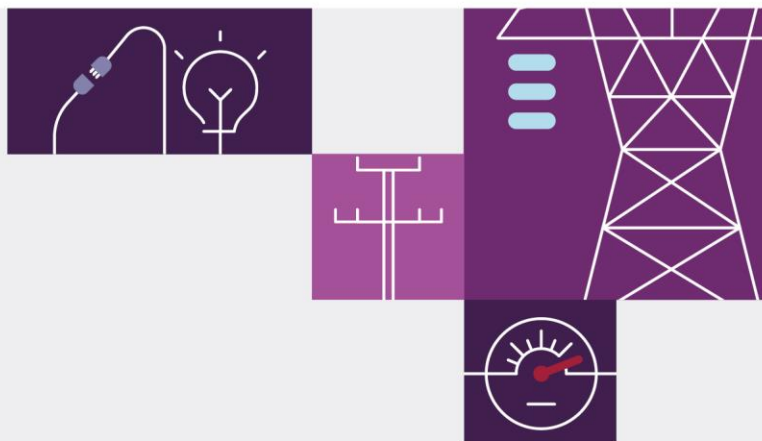

Figure 1 Link to User Guide

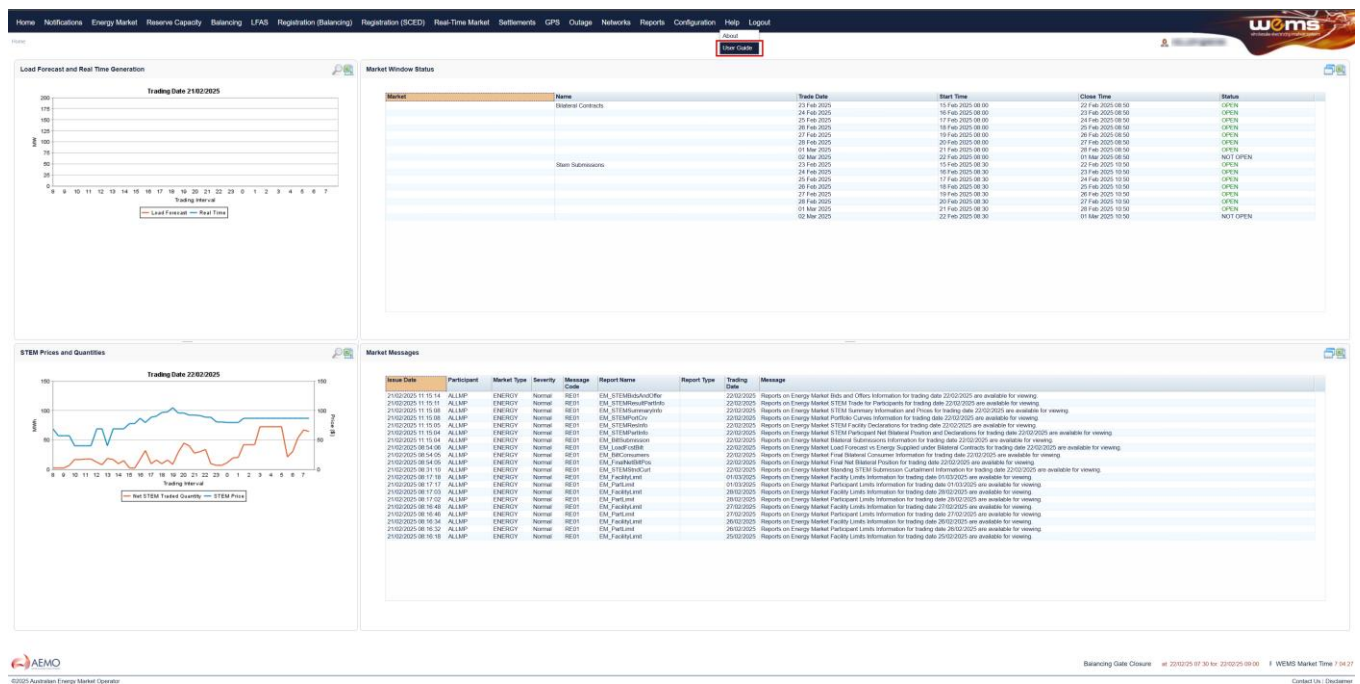


Figure 2 Guides and useful information page

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3 Registration (SCED) - Authorised Person Character Limit

Within the WEMS MPI, under Registration (SCED) → Participant → Participant Information → General Information, the Authorised Person field was limited to 20 characters which restricted the length of the name. This field has been updated to accept up to 30 characters.
